Headed for the beach? Going kayaking or snorkeling? Serenade of the Seas now offers the convenience of using your SeaPass card to borrow as many pool towels as you need. Towels can be checked out at the gangway. Just remember that there's a \$25 replacement fee for all unreturned towels, so please don't leave any behind! We want to keep the beaches and other destinations our guests visit as clean as when we first arrive.

NO FOOD MAY BE TAKEN OFF OR BROUGHT ON THE SHIP

Please remember that absolutely no food may be taken off or brought on the ship in Oranjestad, Aruba. This is per Public Health and Quarantine Regulations. A full quarantine inspection will take place at the gangway when returning to the ship and all bags will be scanned to ensure compliance. We kindly remind our guests that plants, flowers, seeds (for agriculture purposes) and bulbs are prohibited items and will be confiscated at the gangway.

TAKE PRECAUTIONS ASHORE

When you go ashore, take reasonable precautions. Remain aware of your surroundings. Try to stay in groups. And do not leave your personal belongings unattended or in the care of a stranger.

SAFETY WARNING

Serious accidents and fatalities have occurred when guests have rented or taken independent tours involving mopeds, jeeps, scooters, or wave runners (jet skis). Royal Caribbean strongly recommends that guests do not participate in such activities while ashore.

Please refrain from bringing any sea shells aboard upon your return to the ship. They are subject to confiscation by local authorities.

NOTICES

Helpful Health Information - Medical experts tell us that the best way to prevent colds, flu or gastrointestinal illnesses - such as a Norovirus that can be transferred easily through person-to-person contact - is to simply wash your hands thoroughly with soap and warm water after restroom breaks and again before eating anything. Symptoms of Noroviruses include an upset stomach, vomiting and diarrhea. According to the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Noroviruses affect 23 million Americans on land each year. In fact, the only illness that is more prevalent is the common cold. If you have (or have had in the past 48 hours) any of these symptoms, please do not go to the ship's Medical Facility. Instead, go directly to your stateroom and call Guest Services by dialing "0". The nurse on duty will then return your call for a complimentary telephone consultation. Treatment may be provided on a complimentary basis.

Discharge Of All Garbage Into The Sea Is Prohibited Except As Provided Otherwise - The MARPOL Convention and domestic law generally prohibit the discharge of most forms of garbage from ships into the sea. Violation of these requirements may result in penalties. All garbage is to be retained onboard and placed in the bins provided.

Smoking Policy - We have revised our onboard smoking policy, effective for all sailings departing on or after January 1, 2014. Under this new policy, all indoor public spaces will be smoke free, with the exception of the Casino. In the Casino, there will be designated smoking and non-smoking areas. Additionally, smoking will not be permitted in the staterooms or on stateroom balconies. Outdoor smoking areas will be designated on the starboard side. Please also note that smoking-like products such as electronic cigarettes or e-cigarettes are only permitted within the designated smoking areas.

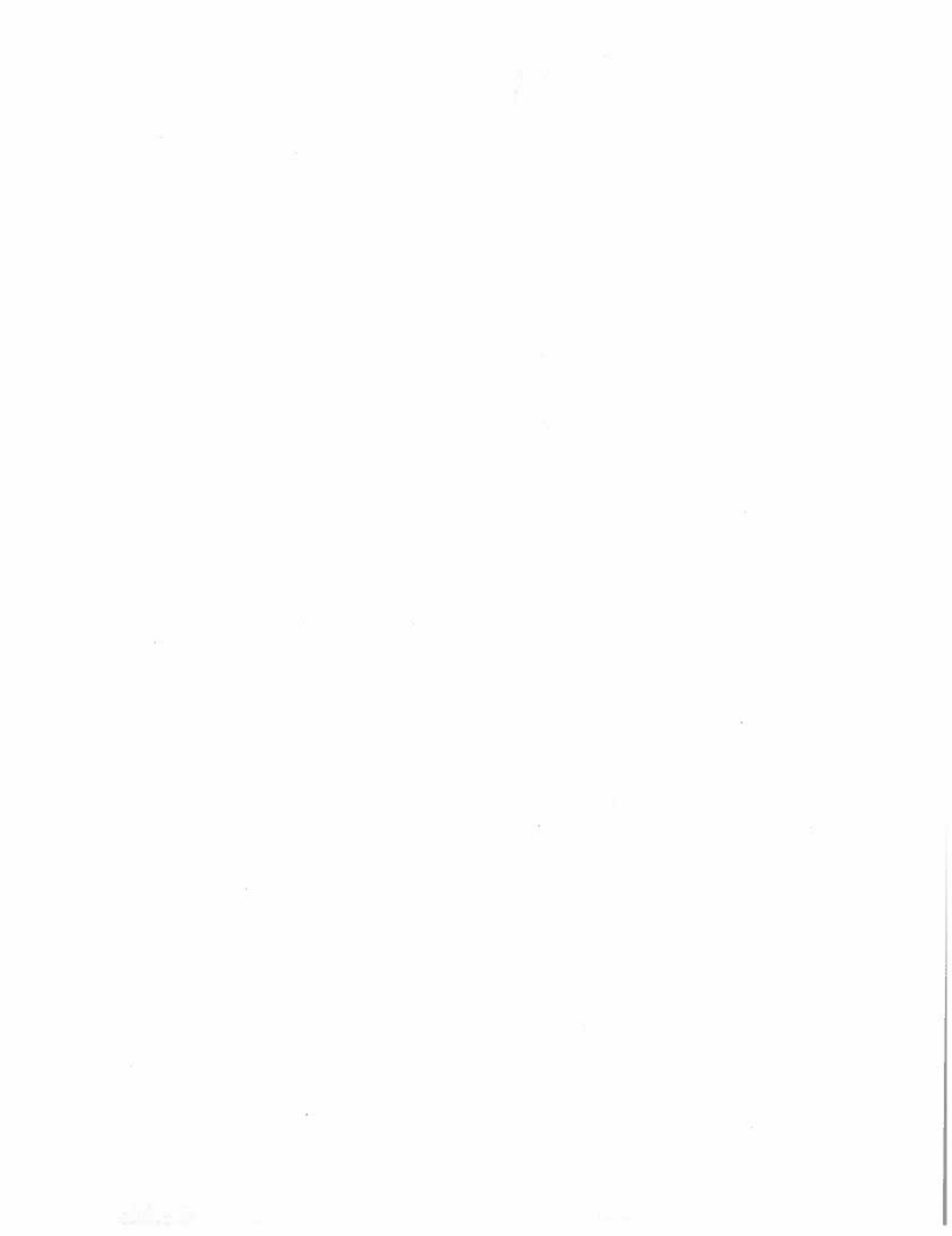

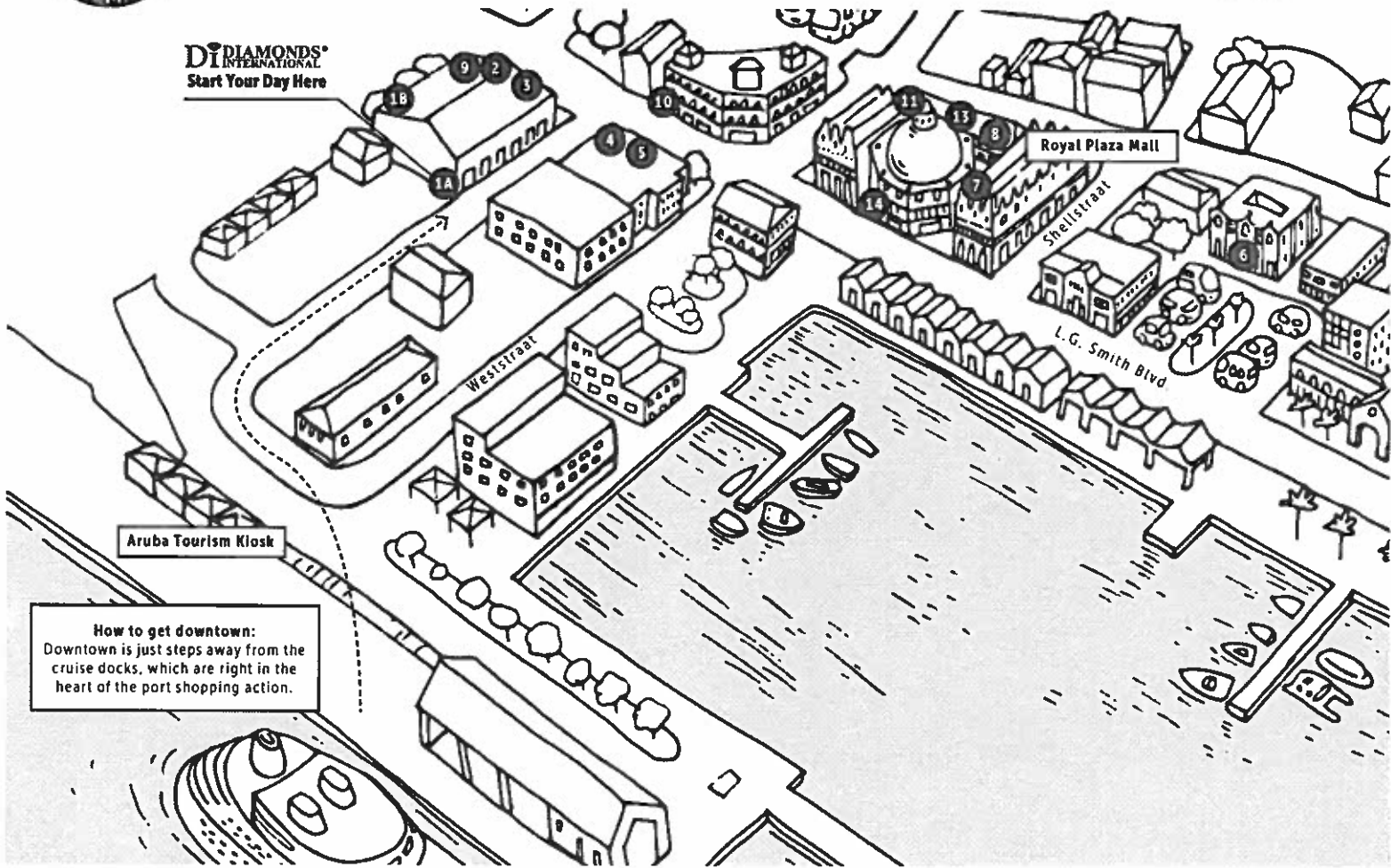

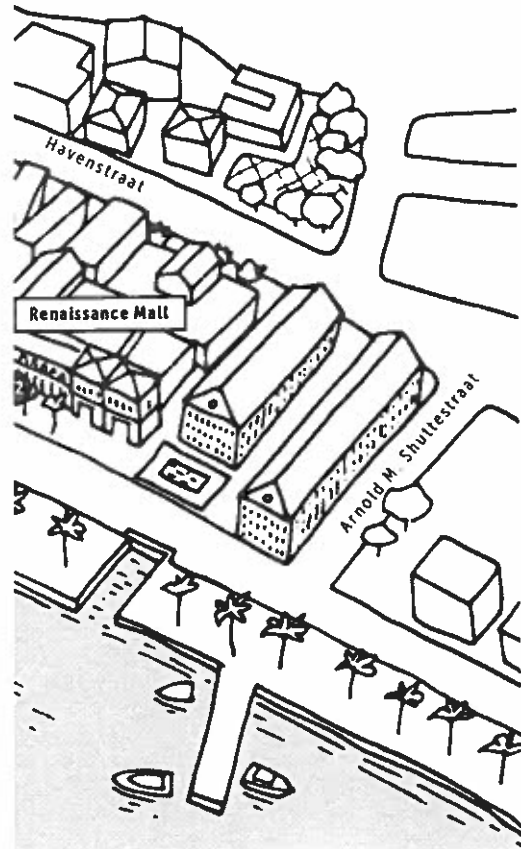

LOCAL CUISINE & DRINKS

Aruba's multicultural heritage and its neighbors have influenced its diverse gastronomy. You can find succulent Argentine meat dishes, Venezuelan imports like *empanadas* (meat-filled patties) and *arepas* (a cornmeal pancake cooked on a griddle), and nutty Dutch cheeses. Savor Caribbean flavors in hearty soups such as *sopi di pampuna* (pumpkin) and *giambo* (gumbo) with some *pan bati* (a wheat-and-corn flour pancake) or *funchi* (corn-meal mush similar to Italian polenta), which are also the traditional accompaniments to most main dishes. Be sure to try some *pika* (a peppery, vinegar-based condiment), typically used to spice up the super-fresh seafood. Cool off with a Balashi, a golden pilsner brewed on Aruba. A 15% service charge is often included in the bill at restaurants. If not, a gratuity of 10-15% is appropriate.

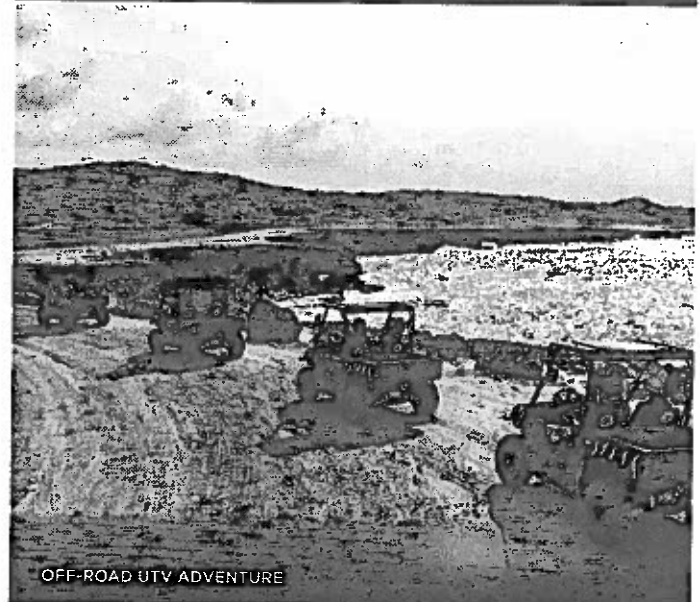
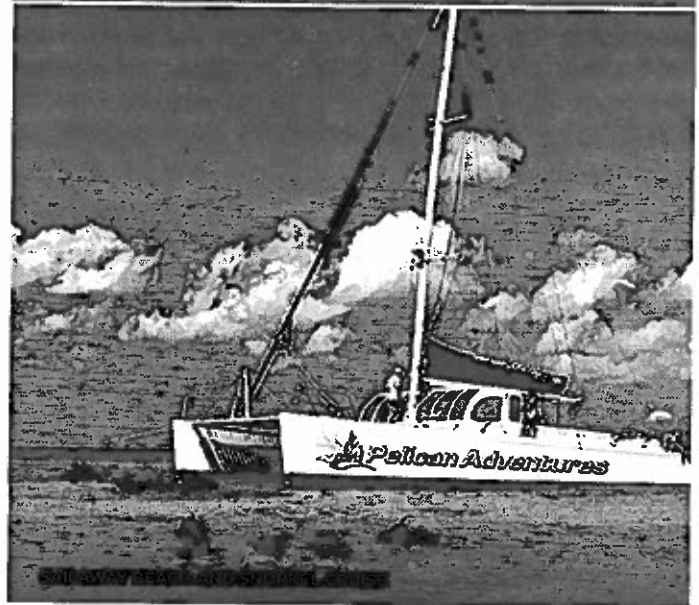

There is no standard written form yet residents must be fluent in both Papiamentu and Dutch to apply for citizenship in these island nations.
- Arikok National Park covers roughly 20% of Aruba's total land mass, an eco-preserve that spans the arid, desert terrain of the eastern interior and dunes and limestone cliffs of the northeast coast. Inside the cave of Baranca Sunu, nicknamed the Tunnel of Love for its heart-shaped entrance, are naturally sculpted rocks that resemble the Madonna and the U.S. President Abraham Lincoln.
- In the mid-1800s, Aruba was known as the world's largest exporter of aloe vera. The first plants were grown on the island's Hato plantation, which is where all Aruban aloe products are produced today.
