BASK IN THE BEAUTY OF BASSETERRE.

Columbus sailed past the island of St. Kitts, never actually landing on its pink-sand beaches. Yet by the time French and English settlers arrived in the 1620's, this lush paradise was known as St. Christopher. The town of Basseterre, one of the oldest in the Eastern Caribbean, was originally part of the French colony. Then in 1727, the British made Basseterre the capital of the entire island. It was right around this time that the world fell in love with sugar. And St. Kitts, with its rich volcanic soil and tropical climate, had just the right conditions for a booming industry. At one point, 68 sugar plantations dotted the 68 square miles island. The glory days of sugar may be long gone, but you can still see remnants of the old plantations in the midst of swaying sugar cane fields. The island's colonial history is also reflected in the abandoned fortresses, city squares and architectural details. And the dormant volcanoes and rugged mountains are the perfect setting for hiking, with spectacular panoramic views from the Crater base of Mount Liamuiga.

ATTENTION GROUPS & FAMILIES

In order not to get separated, please meet on one of the upper decks and only proceed to the gangway when you are all ready to go ashore. To avoid congestion, please do not meet your parties on the gangway due to limited space.

NO FOOD MAY BE TAKEN OFF OR BROUGHT ON THE SHIP

Please remember that absolutely no food may be taken off or brought on the ship. This is per Public Health and Quarantine Regulations. A full quarantine inspection will take place at the gangway when returning to the ship and all bags will be scanned to ensure compliance. We kindly remind our guests that plants, flowers, seeds (*for agriculture purposes*) and bulbs are prohibited items and will be confiscated at the gangway.

TAKE PRECAUTIONS ASHORE

When you go ashore, take reasonable precautions. Remain aware of your surroundings. Try to stay in groups. And do not leave your personal belongings unattended or in the care of a stranger.

WHILE AROUND THE SHIP

Guests are to be cautious when walking on all open decks and on tile surfaces as it can be slippery when wet. We recommend that you hold onto the hand rails when walking up and down stairways. Parents are to ensure that children keep their hands clear of elevator doors.

Don't let a misstep ruin your day in port. Mind your step on uneven sidewalks and streets. And please note that some curbs can be very steep.

CDC Travel Alert: Level II - Practice Enhanced Precautions - Pregnant Women - In an abundance of caution, CDC recommends special precautions for pregnant women and women trying to become pregnant. Discharge Of All Garbage Into The Sea Is Prohibited Except As Provided Otherwise - The MARPOL Convention and domestic law generally prohibit the discharge of most forms of garbage from ships into the sea. Violation of these requirements may result in penalties. All garbage is to be retained onboard and placed in the bins provided.

Smoking Policy - We have revised our onboard smoking policy, effective for all sailings departing on or after January 1, 2014. Under this new policy, all indoor public spaces will be smoke free, with the exception of the Casino. In the Casino, there will be designated smoking and non-smoking areas. Additionally, smoking will not be permitted in the staterooms or on stateroom balconies. Outdoor smoking areas will be designated on the starboard side. Please also note that smoking-like products such as electronic cigarettes or e-cigarettes are only permitted within the designated smoking areas.
